Conditions of Entry

1. Entry forms, payment and craft items must be submitted by 1pm, Saturday 25 October to Campbelltown City Council.
2. The entry fee is \$5 for up to five items, with a \$1 entry fee for each item thereafter. The entry fee is \$2 for the Junior section and \$3 for senior citizens (available upon presentation of a Pensioner Concession Card).
3. A prize of \$20 will be awarded to each first place winner and \$10 for each second place. For the Junior section, a prize of \$10 will be awarded to the first place winner and \$5 for the second place. The overall winner will be awarded \$150. All place getters receive a certificate.
4. Items previously entered in the Fisher's Ghost Craft Exhibition are not eligible for re-entry.
5. All entries must be the original work of the exhibitor and must have been completed over the past 12 months.
6. All items will be accepted for judging, but not necessarily displayed. The display of items is subject to the event organiser's discretion.
7. All care will be taken, but there will be no responsibility for any loss or damage sustained to any exhibit.
8. All craft items are entered at the entrants' own risk. It is recommended that if your work is of great value, then you supply your own property insurance to cover the item/s, at your own expense.
9. The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to participants. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. Submission of entry form, payment and craft items can be lodged at the Campbelltown Council Civic Centre starting Monday 13 October between 8:30am – 4:30pm weekdays. All submissions must be made before 1pm Saturday 25 October.
11. All craft exhibitors must abide by the instructions and directions of the organisers. The organiser is the Fisher's Ghost Sub Committee in association with Campbelltown City Council.
