



Campbelltown City Library Service - Cosplay Etiquette and Weapons Guidelines

Campbelltown City Library is committed to creating a safe environment for everyone attending library events. Some library events encourage participation through cosplay. As such, we have developed the Cosplay Etiquette and Weapons Guidelines to ensure all our visitors have a safe and enjoyable experience at our events.

Cosplay Etiquette

1. All costumes should be family-friendly. Any visitors wearing costumes deemed inappropriate may be asked to change outfits or leave the event.
2. All props should be small and lightweight. Any props deemed inappropriate must be left in your vehicle or given to staff to place into storage until you are leaving the event.
3. Always ask permission before taking a photo or video with or of a cosplayer.
4. Please respect all cosplayers and visitors to the event. If you or someone you know are being harassed or made to feel uncomfortable, please urgently inform a library staff member.

Weapons Guidelines

1. No sharp objects or real weapons are permitted.
2. No projectile weapons are permitted.
3. No weapon play allowed.
4. All weapons must be easily recognisable as props and made of malleable or soft material.
5. Weapons deemed unsuitable will need to be left in your vehicle or given to staff to place into storage until you are leaving the event.
6. The weapons guidelines are in compliance with State Weapon Regulations which includes replica and toy weapons. You can view the NSW State Weapon Laws here: <https://legislation.nsw.gov.au/#/view/regulation/2017/456/full>
