# 1

## A performance with Eaton Gorge Theatre Company – Madam Mulch and the Great Fertiliso

This mystical duo perform mulch magic and fertilising fun in an engaging 50 minute performance. The audience become involved in creating the food cycle and returning nutrients to the ground using compost, mulch and fertiliser to grow food.

# 2

## Supply of a hungry worm bin or compost bin to your school

# 3

## A day of sessions with Enviro Mentors to set up your hardware including sessions on worm farming or composting (up to three sessions) and undertake a snapshot waste audit (after lunch session).

Students will learn fundamental lessons about disposing of the organic waste they generate – both at home and school. The afternoon session will have students dig through the waste from the day and find out how much waste is generated each day at school.

## Requirements to participate:

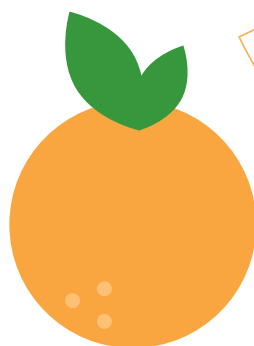
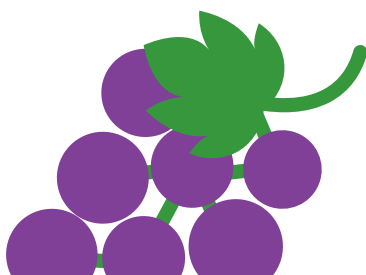
There is no cost to the school to participate in this program.

The only requirement is for the school to measure the food waste they divert from landfill for one week (after installation of the hardware), provide this information to Campbelltown City Council and participate in a follow up survey within 3 months. This is required by the NSW Environment Protection Authority as part of the agreement to fund this program.

We will provide a booklet to each participating school to record this information as part of the program.
