13.1 Questions Without Notice

- 1. Councillor Oates tabled a copy of a letter that was forwarded to the Campbelltown/Airds Historical Society from the NSW Department of Family and Community Services regarding the restoration of Raith House. The letter indicates that it is the Department's intention to fully restore the house in the near future.
- 2. Councillor Borg asked for an update on the closure of the Minto Community Library.
 - Council's Director Community Services advised that the Minto Community Library will be closed to the public from Friday 20 December 2013 in line with the end of school year. Council staff and resources from the Minto Community Library will be redeployed to Council's other libraries and that Council's Manager Library Services has worked closely with members of the community responding to their questions.
