

16. NOTICE OF MOTION

16.1 Badgerys Creek Airport

Councillor Kolkman has given Notice in writing of his intention to move the following Motion at the next meeting of Council on 9 December 2014.

1. That Council call upon the Federal Government to ensure that planning for the new Badgerys Creek Airport proceeds on the basis that it will maintain, as a minimum, a quality of life enjoyed by those who live and work near, or under the flight paths to, Sydney Kingsford Smith Airport - notably in respect of hours of operation.
2. That Council place the above motion on the agenda for the next meeting of MACROC seeking support from our MACROC partners to protect the quality of life of the residents of Macarthur.
3. That Council write to all Federal Members of Parliament in electorates potentially impacted upon by the Badgerys Creek Airport urging them to support Council's aim of preserving the quality of life of their constituents.

- b) this Council resolve to decline any invitation to participate in discussions and or negotiations intended to explore the potential for amalgamation with another Local Government body.

16.3 Downzoning of heights and floor space ratios in Campbelltown CBD

That when the Campbelltown Local Environment Plan is returned to the Council for consideration, a recommendation or option is presented to Councillors which:

In the area currently covered by the Campbelltown (Sustainable City) Development Control Plan:

- a. does not reduce height limits
- b. where floor space ratios limits currently exist, they are not reduced below 3:1
- c. where no floor space ratio limit currently exists and one is to be put into place, it is not set less than 3:1.

- (c) Omission of submissions which submitters have requested to be confidential.
- (d) Removal of parts of submissions which submitters have requested to be confidential.
- (e) Removal of submissions or parts of submissions which in the judgment of the General Manager could present a legal liability to Council.
