GET STARTED:

1 GET TO KNOW YOUR WATER BILL

Understanding how busy periods and changing seasons alter your water bills can help you prepare and develop strategies to ensure you're using water at the most suitable times. Making it better on the budget and the environment.

2 MAKE REPAIRS WHEN NEEDED

Do you have a leaking tap, toilet or shower? Save water and money in the long term and get it repaired. What seems like a minor issue now, can contribute to thousands of litres of water being wasted a year.

3 UNDERSTAND YOUR AREA AND EQUIPMENT

Get to know your equipment's water usage and water rating. Understanding appliances, fixtures and fittings can help your business save water and money. Doing a fixtures and equipment survey is a quick way to see how you can save.

4 THINK ABOUT HOW YOU USE WATER

Often the way we use water can be the cause of high usage. Discuss with staff best practices for high water usage activities such as wash downs and cleaning. Signage for hand washing and other practices can help remind staff to be considerate with their water use.
