
Land for Wildlife

Land for wildlife is a voluntary program, encouraging landowners to register their property to help conserve wildlife habitat in their backyard.

Co-ordinated by the Community Environment Network with Campbelltown Council delivering regional support, we will conduct site assessments, suggestions on management and support.

Program benefits include:

- Eligibility for grants to enhance your property for nature
- Access to education programs and activities
- Connections to network with other members
- Relevant news for management issues
- A sign for participating property owners



Koalatown Certified Properties

Campbelltown is Koalatown. Koalatown aims to raise awareness and empower the community to actively support the conservation of koalas at their homes and in their neighbourhoods.

Become a Koalatown approved rural property by demonstrating the following on your property:

- Plant koala food trees on your property
- Ensure your outer fences are koala friendly:
 - Fence to maintain a 30cm gap at the bottom
 - Wooden posts
 - Not barbed wire
- Ensure your internal fence is secure (Colorbond etc.) to keep your dog in and Koalas out and keep your dog secured at night
- Ensure you have a rope in your pool to prevent a koala from drowning
