

# *BLAIRMOUNT*

Lot 102 DP 708401Badgally Road, Blairmont

Built c. 1880's



**HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:**

Of lesser quality but similar character to Varroville and Hillcrest, but perhaps later in period. Its hipped iron roof and bull-nosed verandah on cast iron columns with a decorative frieze and brackets suggests 1880's. It has wooden slabs stables, now used, as a garage behind which would probably pre-date the house, also an old stone silo. Was once a property belonging to the Rouse Family.

**CONDITION AND USE:**

Converted from original state, with French doors converted to long windows and a modern addition at the rear. It is very well kept with beautiful garden surrounding the house and leading up the driveway. Picturesque settings with a rural backdrop. Used as a private residence.

**HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:**

- One of the later Victorian country homes. Nicely sited and adds name to the locality.
