HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

This was formerly Fieldhouse's Produce Store. "Campbelltown – the Bicentennial History" gives 1853 as the year William and Edwin Hallet Fieldhouse opened their general store. The verandahs were removed when it was converted to house the Campbelltown and Ingleburn News and a front porch was built. An early building of substantial proportions.

CONDITION AND USE:

In the adaptation to its present use much of the early detailing has been lost (small panes and verandah), but its shape and general appearance still suggests an early building. The portico is an addition, perhaps using the original columns.

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:

- The building has historic and architectural significance
- Part of the early character of this end of Queen Street
