Lot 1 DP 74318526 Oxley Street, Campbelltown

Built c. 1830's





HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

A meticulously neat brick house fronting the footpath of Oxley St though originally facing north. Interesting details – brick cornice, wire verandah – fence and wooden latticework. Painted bricks simulate stone quoins. The verandah/façade was added to the building in the 1920's. The building was originally a store, probably built about 1830 as the property deeds are dated 1827.

Until the 1960's there was a two-storey stable and stone house behind the main house. The cellars underneath remain.

CONDITION AND USE:

Has been well maintained and appears in good condition. The grounds and hedges are carefully and neatly kept.

• Provides good value in general townscape.
