DREDGE'S COTTAGE

Lot 111 DP 705804 No. 303 Queen Street, Campbelltown Colonial Style House, built c. 1890's





HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

A good example of the late nineteenth century house containing the style of the colonial period. Behind the 1890's house there is an older 3 roomed cottage. Was part of an important line of buildings before the shop between it and the fire station was demolished. It is now surrounded by car parking for the Campbelltown Mall Complex.

CONDITION AND USE:

Well kept and in use as a Veteran's Recreational Centre.

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:

- The building has historic, architectural and aesthetic significance
- A well maintained cottage of late Victorian age, near the heart of Campbelltown.
