Lot 105 DP 2600047 No. 107 Eagleview Road, Minto Late 19th Century Wooden Vernacular Building





HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

A wooden house with a wide wooden verandah on three sides. French windows with shutters, wooden and pressed iron trim. The verandah is a more recent addition. The main building is a good example of a late nineteenth century wooden vernacular. There is a substantial brick bar close behind the house. It was most likely an early orchard farm.

CONDITION AND USE:

In need of repair. It has lost much of its verandah trim. Used as a dwelling.

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:

- The building has historic and architectural significance
- It is an interesting late example of a weatherboard vernacular building which continues the colonial traditions.
- It represents the phase of late nineteenth century homestead selections in the area.
