HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

This brick house was built in 1890. A very neat, formal and later Victorian house with a verandah on three sides of the house and wooden posts and balustrading. It is several hundred metres north of the site of the original Glen Alpine or Clan Alpine as it was sometimes called

CONDITION AND USE:

Very well maintained, being in character with the neat appearance of the newer neighboring houses of Glen Alpine. A picket fence runs along the frontage to Belltrees Close.

• A good example of a late Victorian country House
