Brick House, built c. 1890's



HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

This brick house stands on land, part of which was granted to David Brady in 1816 and part to John Warby in the same year. The windows have sills and shutters, the verandah floor of wood and there is a deep decorative wooden valance under the verandah eaves. A bell cast roof extends around two sides on the east and south sides of the house. A similarly detailed but partly enclosed verandah is on the north side. French doors open onto the south verandah and there were marble fireplaces inside.

CONDITION AND USE:

The building is owned by the Department of Housing. After acquisition in the 1960-70's it was renovated and a small timber and glass addition added at the rear to facilitate its use as a community center.

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:

- The building has Architectural and Aesthetic significance
- An early building which is of value to the adjacent residential area
