

## *HOUSE – OXLEY STREET*

Lot 1 DP 555265 No. 24 Oxley Street, Campbelltown

Two Storey Brick House, built c. 1860's



## **HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:**

An early two-storey house, c. 1860s. Walls are of rendered brick and the hipped roof corrugated iron. The two-storey iron lace verandahs look out over a mature garden.

The detached kitchen was demolished in the early 1970's to make way for a new dwelling.

## **CONDITION AND USE:**

Its condition appears to be good. It is currently used as a chiropractor's surgery.

## **HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:**

- The building has historic and architectural significance
  - Provides an interesting Victorian note in the townscape of the Moore/Oxley Street, as does Caversham next door.
