HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

The Ingleburn Primary School was established in 1887 in a building relocated from Brooks Point near Appin, where the water construction camp was being dismantled. It was replaced with a new building in 1892.

CONDITION AND USE:

Still in use as a school building.

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:

- The building has Historical and Social significance
- It is of local significance to Campbelltown because of its continued use as a school building since 1892 and the site from 1887.
