MENANGLE HOUSE (FORMER HORSE AND JOCKEY INN)

Lot 102 DP 776612 Menangle Park Road (Cnr. Racecourse Avenue), Menangle Park Built c. 1820's & 1865



HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

This two storey brick building was once the Horse and Jockey Inn. It has the typical characteristics of the colonial era, the symmetrical arrangement of the doors and windows, shutters, a fanlight above the front door. The cast iron lace verandah is a later embellishment, as is the brick front extension. Dates back to the 1820's with the extension being built in 1865.

An early commercial building once and an inn on the southern route.

CONDITION AND USE:

Appears to be in good order and well maintained. The cast iron on the verandah would be a later embellishment.

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:

• A substantial building in the Colonial manner close to Menangle Road. A readily apparent landmark.
