HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

An early link with Campbelltown's pioneering days, this cemetery includes the burials of Thomas Jenner Winton, Campbelltown Council's first Town Clerk; William Webb, founder of Campbelltown's first newspaper, the "Campbelltown Herald" in 1880; and members of the Nicol Family.

The oldest gravestone is dated 1865.

CONDITION AND USE:

The cemetery has not been used for burials for a long time and is open as a public reserve. It is in reasonable condition.

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:

- The site has historical and social significance
- It provides a link with Campbelltown's pioneers
