

PRESBYTERIAN CEMETERY

Lot Pt 1 DP 596379 Cnr Broughton Street and Moore Oxley Bypass,
Campbelltown

Cemetery established after 1837



HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

This burial ground was given to the Presbyterian Church by Alex McDonald (d. 1847). (The Presbyterian church was established in Campbelltown in 1837, when Rev. Hugh R Gilchrist took up residence in Ivy Cottage in Allman Street).

The tombs of the Howe Family of Glenlee are to be found here.

The fine row of trees along the median strip of the Moore/Oxley bypass provide a good setting, together with the trees at the back of the burial ground.

The oldest existing grave is dated 1848.
