HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

This large, sixteen room Indian bungalow-style house was built for H.J.M. Merewether and his bride, Wilhelmina Gore, daughter of Campbelltown bank Manager, A.J. Gore. The building was designed by Wardell & Denning in 1903 and built by D. McIntyre and Sons of Sydney at a cost of 3000 pounds.

Well maintained with renovation being undertaken in 1993.
