

RIVERVIEW

Lot 2 DP 589899 Menangle Road, Menangle Park
Single storey veranda cottage, built 1860



HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

Single storey cottage of clinker brick with symmetrical three bay verandah, unusual pitching to corrugated iron roof and externally expressed fireplaces. Six paned shuttered windows with additional half panes and four-panelled door. Verandah retiled in ceramic, posts altered.

Built C. 1860 by publican of nearby horse and Jockey Inn (now Meanagle House).

CONDITION AND USE:

Reasonably kept and still used as a private residence.

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:

- The building has historic, architectural and aesthetic significance
- Good example of mid 19th century cottage, with some unusual features. Was associated with the nearby ex-inn.
