

ST ELMO

Lot 2 DP 221454 No. 94 Broughton Street, Campbelltown
Two storey rendered brick house, built c.1880's



HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

A substantial two storey house from about the 1880's set on the hill overlooking the town. It has a protruding bay window carried up to the two storeys and cast iron balustrading, frieze and brackets on the veranda, which runs around two sides of the house. The house has a slate roof with iron roofing over the verandah. Fanlight and sidelights around doors on both floors. Modern brick fence. Has an old barn behind it.

CONDITION AND USE:

Well maintained. Was divided into flats at one stage, but now used as a single dwelling.

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:

- Of architectural and aesthetic significance
- Adds a note to the diversity of Campbelltown's building types and is prominent on its hill-side site.
