

ST JOHN THE EVANGELIST ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

In the Australasian Builders and Contractors News of 1 October 1887, notice was taken of a new Catholic Church at Campbelltown designed by Barlow and Roskell. This is the core of the present building.

CONDITION AND USE:

Modern additions surround the earlier building and terracotta Marseilles tiles disguise its early character.

HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:
