

# *STONE COTTAGE*

Lots 55-68 Section 2 DP 2189 No. 28 Mercedes Road, Ingleburn  
Late Georgian Stone Cottage



**HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:**

This small house, though of stone, is difficult to date and may date from the late rather than the early ninetieth century. Its façade is not strictly symmetrical; windows have four panes, and the door four panels. The stone outbuilding is of rusticated, not ashlar stone, denoting a later date.

**CONDITION AND USE:**

Used as a dwelling. Maintenance fair.

A conservation report accompanied a recent Development Application.

**HERITAGE SIGNIFICANCE:**

- The cottage has historic, architectural and aesthetic significance
- An attractive sandstone building of near-original condition; and
- Possibly the oldest surviving building in Ingleburn.
