

THE PINES, MENANGLE PARK

Late Colonial Stone House, Built c.1870



HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION:

A very good late example of the classical colonial stone house. The Pines has a symmetrical façade with French windows opening onto the front veranda, a slate roof and two rear service wings enclosing a small grassed courtyard.

It was built by Edward John Edrop about 1870.

CONDITION AND USE:

In use as a private dwelling.

- The building has architectural and aesthetic significance
- A fine stone house with colonial tradition.
