Dear Mr Tosi,

Thank you for your letter of 4 September 2012 regarding Ingleburn train station.

On 23 April 2012 the NSW Government announced a new Transport Access Program which will deliver accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure where it is needed most. This includes station upgrades, better interchanges, ferry wharf upgrades and commuter car parks. The Transport Access Program includes more than \$770 million for improvements over four years.

Over \$100 million was allocated in the first round of the Transport Access Program, which will see improvements at over 35 locations in coming months.

On 14 September 2012, I announced a major upgrade would be delivered for Ingleburn Station. Now that Ingleburn has been identified for an upgrade, the NSW Government will undertake work to determine the scope of what is needed to make the station accessible for customers, including those in wheelchairs, the elderly and families with prams.

Lifts, new stairs, a revamped station entrance, upgrades to the concourse and improvements to the existing car park and drop off zones will be considered as part of a package of improvements at the station.

The Transport Access Program is part of the NSW Government's commitment to improve public transport services and provide a world-class transport system people want to use.

Thank you for bringing this matter to my attention.
