13.1 Questions Without Notice

- 1. Councillor Brticevic noted that a number of maintenance issues at Blair Athol Community Hall have been brought to his attention and asked the Director City Works if he could have them attended to.
 - Council's Director City Works advised that he would arrange for an inspection to be undertaken and the necessary works to be carried out.
- Councillor Chanthivong referred to his previous requests resulting from inquiries from local residents for Council to investigate the feasibility of installing a roundabout at the intersection of Guernsey Avenue and Jenner Street, Leumeah and asked if he could be advised as to the current status of this request.
