

13. QUESTIONS WITHOUT NOTICE

13.1 Questions Without Notice

1. Councillor Oates noted that there are two large banners advertising supplements located on the external fence of Campbelltown Sports Stadium and asked why they are there and if they are considered appropriate.

The General Manager advised that he would arrange for this matter to be investigated.

2. Councillor Glynn noted that Alyson Annan has recently been appointed to the Australian Hall of Fame and asked if consideration could be given to amending the plaque attached to her display case located at level three at the Civic Centre Administration building being reflected to note this achievement.

The General Manager advised that he will make arrangements for the plaque to be altered as requested.

3. Councillor Brticevic noted that he had received advice from a resident indicating that animal faeces and other rubbish is being dumped in a lane way in Oswald Crescent, Rosemeadow.

The Director Planning and Environment advised that he would arrange for Council's Rangers to inspect the lane way as requested.

4. Councillor Brticevic noted that private and commercial vehicles are continually parking in the designated Australia Post parking space in Patrick Street, Campbelltown inconveniencing Australia Post in the carrying out of their duties.

The Director Planning and Environment advised that he would investigate this issue as requested.

5. Councillor Brticevic referred to the Child Care Centre in Denham Court noting that staff park their vehicles on the grassed areas adjacent to the centre. Councillor Brticevic noted that instructions received by the Land and Environment Court required staff to park their vehicles in designated parking areas and asked if this issue could be investigated, with a view to ensuring that staff park in the appropriate locations.

The Director Planning and Environment advised that he would investigate the matter as requested.

6. Councillor Brticevic asked if he could be provided with an update on all issues in relation to Nustas Demolition and Excavation at Ingleburn.

The Director Planning and Environment advised that he would investigate the matter and provide Councillors with updated information.

7. Councillor Bricevic passed on his best wishes to Councillor Borg for the successful running of the 2013 24 Hour Fight Against Cancer.
8. Councillor Borg thanked Council staff for their ongoing support in the 2013 24 Hour Fight Against Cancer. Councillor Borg indicated that this year's event will be bigger than previous years with the expectation of 1500 participants and a record number of teams entering the event.

Councillor Borg indicated the support from Council was fantastic and he congratulated the Mayor Councillor Mead as being patron of this year's event.

9. Councillor Lake referred to a letter that the General Manager sent to Wests Tigers seeking advice as to the number of games that will be played at Campbelltown Sports Stadium in 2014 and asked if he had received a response to his enquiry.

The General Manager advised that he has received a verbal response that four home games would be played at the Campbelltown Sports Stadium in 2014 and that upon receiving a formal confirmation, he would present a report to Council.

10. Councillor Thompson referred to the recent landscaping works undertaken at Redfern Road and noted that the *Bottlebrush* planted are in flower and look magnificent.

11. Councillor Hawker indicated that he had recently attended:

- AGM - Family Support Services and indicated that it was great to see the support that this service continues to provide
- Domestic Violence Forum which was attended by a large crowd and he was heartened to see what this service provides to address domestic violence within the Local Government Area.

12. Councillor Kolkman indicated that during the last Federal election campaign, Federal Member for Macarthur, Russell Matheson indicated that a successful Liberal Government would contribute \$500,000 to the Macarthur Rams to assist in the provision of a synthetic turf playing surface.

The General Manager advised that once he has had discussions with the Federal Member for Macarthur and the Macarthur Football Association he will provide an update to the Council.
